<u>**GiftCards/Checks:**</u> The Catholic Charities Sterling Food Pantry accepts checks or gift cards (Wegmans preferred) to purchase needed items. Wegmans gift cards are used to buy milk for our clients.

<u>Checks</u>: make payable to "Catholic Charities" and put "Loudoun Regional Office" (or "LRO") in the memo portion. **Gift Cards**: mark envelope with "Catholic Charities" (or "CCDA").

Place the checks or gift cards in the lock box labeled "Divine Mercy Outreach." They are mounted on the wall by each Church entrance. (Note: the box in the Narthex is located by the elevator). The DMO Director will arrange to deliver the donations to the Pantry.
