Priority Items:

Spaghetti Jar Sauce (no glass, Ragu, etc.) AND Tomato Products Snacks (individually wrapped) Canned Meals (chili, stew, etc.) Oil (no larger than 48 oz) Jelly (no Peanut Butter) Other Items:

Tuna

Rice (1-3 lb bags – no larger) Soup (canned and boxed broth) Pancake Mix and Syrup Canned and Dry Beans (black preferred) Canned Corn (and other veggies) Canned Fruit Mac and Cheese Ramen Oatmeal (1 lb canister or small box) Cereal Pasta and Spaghetti Canned Chicken

Toiletry Items:

Shampoo Conditioner Body Wash (liquid) Deodorant Toothbrushes & Toothpaste Reusable grocery bags (new or gently used – no plastics)

Checks: Loudoun

Food Pantry accepts checks or gift cards (Wegmans preferred) to purchase needed items.

Checks: make payable to "Catholic Charities" and put "Loudoun Regional Office" (or "LRO") in the memo portion. **Gift Cards**: mark envelope with "Catholic Charities" (or "CCDA").
